Presents Find A Truck

A Family-Friendly, Covid-conscious, Socially-Distanced Scavenger Hunt

Northern East Bay, CA. – On **Saturday, April 17**, The Junior League of Oakland-East Bay (JLOEB) invites families with children of all ages and adults for a safe, socially-distant scavenger hunt event that is guaranteed to be more fun than a virtual one! The event is set to begin from 9:30 am to 2 pm.

The original event, *Touch a Truck*, was set to launch in 2020 but was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic and social distancing requirements. For JLOEB to continue its fundraising efforts, *Touch a Truck* was creatively reinvented this year to ***Find-a-Truck Scavenger Hunt***.

Find a Truck is a socially-distant scavenger hunt event for families and folks of all ages. It is a unique event that allows children to still see, find, and learn about their favorite big trucks and heavy machinery – but now from the safety of their own vehicle! Vehicles on display will include tractors, big rigs, emergency responders, tractor-trailers, utility trucks, and more!

The scavenger hunt locations will include: *Concord, Walnut Creek, Lafayette, Orinda, & Moraga*, Ticket prices for the event will be \$20 per vehicle and plan to go on sale the week of March 15th!

The Junior League of Oakland-East Bay organizes these types of fundraisers to support the League's efforts to improve the lives of children and families in the community. Last year we were able to donate \$7,000 to '18 Reasons,' a nonprofit cooking school on a mission to empower our community and 'Love Never Fails,' an organization created to stop human trafficking.
