



Gift Acceptance Policy

The Junior League of Oakland-East Bay (JLOEB) values and will protect its integrity and independence and the freedom to pursue its Mission. This policy is designed to provide guidance to JLOEB and to the general public to ensure that the process of giving and acceptance of charitable contributions and sponsorships is consistent with the Mission and Vision and Reaching Out Statement of The Junior League, as well as the stated purposes and priorities of JLOEB.

JLOEB advises all prospective donors to seek the assistance of independent legal and financial counsel prior to making a contribution.

Donations of money, goods and services may be sought from individuals, corporations and foundations. JLOEB will generally accept all gifts that are offered in the spirit of charity and civic service.

JLOEB will not accept gifts that are too restrictive in purpose or inconsistent with the Junior League Mission, Vision and Reaching Out Statement and the JLOEB's stated purposes and priorities or that limit the implementation of JLOEB's programs and activities.

JLOEB will not accept gifts that limit it from accepting gifts from other donors except as approved by the Board.

JLOEB will not accept gifts that may expose it to adverse publicity, or involve it in unexpected responsibilities because of their source, condition or purposes, or that require expenditures of money or time beyond the scope of the League's resources.

JLOEB will not accept gifts that involve unlawful discrimination based on sex, age, national origin, color, disability or any other basis prohibited by federal, state, provincial or local laws and regulations. Nor will JLOEB accept gifts that oblige it to violate any other law or regulation.
